DONINGTON

Cars must be presented in an acceptable fashion. You have a duty to your sponsors and to Caterham to ensure that the cars are properly presented.

CATERHAM CHAMPIONSHIP 2006

We do not at this stage have information regarding regulations calendar, costs etc for next year but I can confirm that pre registrations are coming in quickly now for the 2006 Roadsport Championship.

Roadsport B is currently full with around 45 pre registrations so far. Roadsport Inter will change its name next year and will simply be entitled Roadsport Challenge. I have in the region of 18 pre registrations so far, current list attached.

As I have stated before, Competitors in the Roadsport Challenge Championship will be eligible to enter the Caterham Eurocup minimum National A licence required. This will give you a chance to race on the wonderful circuits on offer in Europe, e.g. Nurburgring, Spa, Dijon, Hockenheim , and have a lot of fun on the way!

This year there were 6 double headed events, each with 2x20 min qualifying and 2,x 25 min races. Professional team support was allowed and cars were run on Hankook all weather tyres.

We do not have details of next years format at present but will obviously let you know as soon as we can.
