## **SILVERSTONE**

You should have received your final instructions for this event. Please read carefully, especially item 13. Race Start Procedure. For those of you racing on the National Circuit for the first time you must attend a first time drivers briefing which will be held at the following times:

Saturday 08.15 09.00 10.00 and 11.30 am. You must attend one of these briefings before practice.

Please do not forget that we have our special Championship briefing, to be taken by the Senior Clerk, Bernard Cottrell, to be held at 13.15 on the first floor of race control.

Both these briefings are mandatory and you will be fined if you do not attend.

I will ask for trophies to be presented on the podium, as you requested. If time does not allow this they will be presented at prize giving, along with the Minister Driver of the Day trophies. This will take place at the end of the Roadsport Inter race on Saturday,

at approximately 4.30, beside Caterham Midlands awning.

On Sunday, time permitting, I will present Roadsport B awards as soon after the race as possible, likewise for Inter.
